- 1 Thursday** — Igor is one of the broadcasters of the program in Russia, and considers it a dream to serve God this way. He is now rejoicing because his seventeen year old daughter just made a public commitment to Jesus by being baptised.
- 2 Friday** — The proposed evangelism center in Kiev is getting closer to becoming a reality. There are still some financial and logistical hurdles to be overcome as FEBC looks to move forward on purchasing a building in early 2019.
- 3 Saturday** — Our board of directors meets today. Much of the discussion will revolve around the ongoing transition and future of the ministry. Please ask God to direct the meeting and provide all wisdom to the board members.
- 4 Sunday** — After reading an article on the AWMedia website, Farhad, an Iranian man made contact and said he has done a lot of research and come to the conclusion that Jesus is the only Saviour. He then asked for help becoming a Christian.
- 5 Monday** — Alexey in St. Petersburg works with the social media team for FEBC Russia. His responsibilities include getting the programs across the internet channels, and also responding to listeners when they reach out with questions.
- 6 Tuesday** — Jim Howlett produces “The Pensive Mr. Howlett” for HopeStreamRadio. On this program, Jim shares stories from his own life and the lessons God has taught him through them. We are thankful for Jim’s contribution to HSR.
- 7 Wednesday** — We continue to pray for more opportunities to present the truth of Jesus Christ in Latin America. The internet opens up opportunities in countries where we do not have direct access to radio broadcasts.
- 8 Thursday** — Ukrainian listener Anna writes, “I came to know Christ through your programs. At first, all these religious things were strange to me, and now I cannot imagine my life without Jesus. He is the source for my life, my best friend.”
- 9 Friday** — Today we again give thanks to God for Ron Hughes, and his 25 years of faithful service to the ministry at FBH International. During these years, the Lord has used Ron to spread the Good News about Jesus throughout the world.
- 10 Saturday** — Arab City Projects is a new initiative that will place response workers within a specific city to see what the appetite for the Gospel is in that area. They will connect with those who want to know more and help them to find truth in Jesus.
- 11 Sunday** — It is Remembrance Day. We remember and thank God for the brave men and women who sacrificed their lives for freedom. We acknowledge them, as the freedom they fought for allows us to preach the Gospel to the world.
- 12 Monday** — Jodi Greenstreet produces “Wow Living” while working full time for Cross-Trainers Canada, a ministry that seeks to provide the community with practical help, and to share the love of Christ.
- 13 Tuesday** — A few weeks ago, the flooding of the Paraguay River near Asuncion forced the evacuation of nearly 1,800 families. This put almost 5,000 people into 58 shelters, facing the uncertainty of what will become of their homes.
- 14 Wednesday** — The city of Pokrovsk in Ukraine is a coal-mining city. Almost every family is tied in some way to the mines. It is also the site of one FEBC’s newest stations, sharing the Gospel with the thousands of listeners they have already.
- 15 Thursday** — 2018 has been a busy and exciting time at FBH International. Continue to pray for us for wisdom, patience and energy as we go about our daily tasks, and work to bring honour and glory to God.
- 16 Friday** — Over the past three months, the highest number of responses in the Arab World have come from Egypt, Algeria, and Saudi Arabia. The contacts were almost evenly split between male and female. Also, nine baptisms took place.

- 17 Saturday** — Tatiana is an atheist in Moscow who has recently started listening to FEBC programs and has found them to be influential and very interesting. Pray that as she listens, Tatiana will accept the Lord as her Saviour.
- 18 Sunday** — HopeStreamRadio's social media presence has seen enormous growth over the past year. Through sites like Facebook and Twitter, we have been able to share our programs, and encouraging scriptures around the world.
- 19 Monday** — Nathan continues to travel to various local churches and conferences throughout Mexico to speak and promote his program *Clasificacion A*. Please pray for Nathan and his family as they travel and serve the Lord.
- 20 Tuesday** — A mother in Ukraine has shared her concerns about her daughter. Both were saved while listening to FEBC broadcasts, and her daughter had become active in ministry. Now, something happened and she has left the church.
- 21 Wednesday** — For the past 15 years, Deborah has been such an integral part of the work here at FBH International. Join us in both giving thanks, and praying for Deborah as she continues to serve the Lord faithfully at FBH.
- 22 Thursday** — Hamza and Rana have experienced physical violence and immense pressure from their families to reject Christ. Both have remained faithful, even after Hamza was arrested for helping Rana flee from her home.
- 23 Friday** — Kristina had been suffering from depression and panic attacks when an old friend pointed her to FEBC radio. She began listening daily, and eventually reached out to them. She now has a relationship with the Lord Jesus.
- 24 Saturday** — As we look to grow the content on the media stream, we have a need for new producers of weekly programs. Please pray to this end, and if you know someone who might be a good fit, feel free to contact us at HopeStreamRadio.
- 25 Sunday** — On July fourth, our bulletin asked for prayer for Nicaragua. We have learned recently that a new Christian radio station has been launched there, and will be broadcasting Nathan's programs into this country.
- 26 Monday** — The ministry in Ukraine is developing a series of programs specifically for children and young teens. Programs will be a combination of audio and video, with questions and honest dialogue about Jesus.
- 27 Tuesday** — Once again we give thanks to God for His continued provision to FBH International. We also ask that he will continue to sustain the ministry as we seek to fulfill His commandment to preach the Gospel to every nation.
- 28 Wednesday** — A new study has found that the Middle East and Northern Africa suffer from the world's highest depression rates. The problem is significantly worse in refugee camps, where it affects two in every five migrants.
- 29 Thursday** — Dmitri became a Christian many years ago, and is thankful for the radio ministry in Moscow, as many Christian stations have shut down. We are reminded of the challenges faced in this country for sharing the Gospel.
- 30 Friday** — With Christmas approaching fast, HopeStreamRadio will soon begin airing special features and programs focused on the birth of Christ. We pray that our listeners will be encouraged throughout this season of hope.
